Ministries

All Age Sunday School

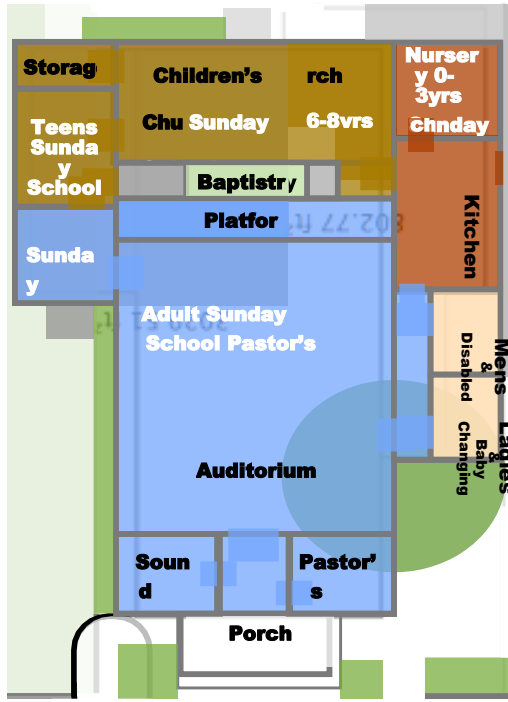
